TASTING

APPEARANCE : Ruby-red colour, deep, ruby red highlights.

NOSE : Fruity, generous, generous red fruit aromas, generous spice aromas, generous liquorice aromas, subtle oak aromas.

PALATE : Straightforward, generous, round, generous red fruit hints, generous spice hints, generous liquorice hints, soft tannin, smooth tannin, round, structured body, good intensity, good length.
