TASTING

APPEARANCE : Terra cotta colour, intense, terra cotta highlights.

NOSE : Aromatic, complex, subtle violet aromas, slight forest floor aromas, subtle burlat cherries aromas, intense fruit jam aromas, cocoa aromas, subtle black pepper aromas, slight vanilla aromas, leather aromas.

PALATE : Generous, velvety, subtle violet overtones, intense forest-floor hints, liquorice hints, generous cooked fruit hints, liquorice hints, leather hints, leather hints, soft tannin, silky tannin, ripe tannin, round, structured body, good intensity, good length.
